
As we have taken part in the "Jerusalem Climbs" almost every year for the last fifteen years, I have many friends there, both Jewish and Arab.

On Easter Monday, I got up at five in the morning and walked with a team of young people to Nicopolis, 34 kilometers on the road to Emmaus, or rather, on one of the possible roads!

## **Global Christian Forum**

Along with Olivier Fleury, I was invited to take part in the fourth gathering of the Global Christian Forum (GCF) held in Accra (Ghana) in April 2024. This Forum brings together around the same table the two major currents of world Christianity that have marked the 20th century: the "ecumenical" current and the "evangelical-pentecostal" current. These two trends have developed in parallel, sometimes in opposition. The aim of the Forum is to bring them together.



How can we do this? Above all, by getting to know each other better, by sharing our "faith journeys", by finding out how each of us met Christ and walked with Him!

The theme of the gathering was "So that the world may know" (John 17:23). In a preface to Olivier Fleury's book of the same title, written especially for the Global Christian Forum, the General Secretary, Pastor Casely Essamuah, states:

"Our theme fits perfectly with the title of Olivier Fleury's book and the aim of the JC2033 initiative: to mobilize Christians throughout the world in the joy of the unity we share with one another because we serve one Lord and have one hope, to galvanize us to share the Gospel in our different contexts. I warmly recommend this book."

Invited to share his experience in the plenary session, O. Fleury exhorted the 250 leaders with his words: "Christ is Risen. The world must know it. The world must believe it. But how can they believe? I'd like to tell you that we have an incredible opportunity before US: the 2000th anniversary of the resurrection of Jesus. He is alive, and he wants to give us full life, now and for eternity".

We are grateful to have been invited to this gathering, and to have been able to talk about the year 2033 as a wonderful opportunity to bear witness. "Many people knew us. There's a real friendship and trust developing that will bear fruit. We've become recognized players," Says Olivier.

# Togo



After the Global Christian Forum meeting in Accra, Ghana, Olivier Fleury and I travelled to neighboring Togo for a few visits.

On the first day, we took part in an Assembly of God service at the Akato-Démé temple in Lomé. We addressed the many children (see photo) and then the congregation.

The next day, we visited pastors from the Assemblies of God, who had been specially summoned for the occasion. "Your message got through. Thank you very much. We want to concentrate on what's essential in all the churches: the Risen Jesus, whom we want to celebrate," said Saram Ankou, their General Secretary.

We had an excellent meeting with the leaders of the Focolare Movement and Youth With A Mission. It seemed to us that God had lit a spark between these two movements, such was the joy of the meeting! May it ignite the whole of Africa for 2033!

The Bible Society of Togo works with all the member churches of the Christian Council. It is without doubt the most ecumenical organization in the country. Estelle Akouegnon, the general secretary, recalls that a major Bible distribution program was launched to mark the 2000th anniversary of the birth of Jesus. She thinks that something similar could be done for 2033. At the end of this brief but intense visit, O. Fleury made this observation, "I remember Billy Wilson, the president of the Pentecostal World Fellowship, telling

This visit confirmed it for me. Africa's vocation is to pass on the faith. We need Africa, and Togo in particular.

# « Easter Together 2025 » - Nicaea

JC2033 is taking part in the "Easter together 2025" initiative. The year 2025 marks the 1700th anniversary of the first Council of Nicaea (325 AD), and the date of Easter will be shared by all Christians.

This Council was an example of how people could make decisions together in difficult times and from different cultures. The foundations of the Christian faith were laid.

It was also at Nicaea that it was decided how to calculate the date of the Christian Easter: the Sunday following the first full moon after the start of spring.

Later the use of different calendars meant that the date of Easter differed between East and West, so that it only occasionally coincides (for example, in this year 2024, there is a difference of more than a month).

But in 2025 all the Churches will celebrate Easter on the same day. An appeal will be made to ensure that the road to 2033 is also an opportunity to call for the date of Easter to be unified.
