Editorial: Christmas: a birth to a spiritual family

Giving birth, raising and sending! These are the three functions of a mother. They are also the three missions of the Church.

For me, taking part in the JC2033 initiative has meant broadening my spiritual family. It has enabled me to meet and work with so many people from every continent.

The unity of the Easter date and 2033. Meeting with Patriarch Bartholomew


